STRATEGIES FOR SOLVING SCIENCE SPECIALTY CLUES

1. Look for the "-ology" Suffix

Identify the Root Word

Every science specialty has a root word that indicates what is being studied. For instance, "entom-" refers to insects, "botan-" refers to plants, and "ge-" refers to the Earth. If you can learn the most

common Greek and Latin roots used in scientific terminology, you will be able to guess the answer even if you have never seen the clue before. 3. Use Crossword

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Patterns and Letter Counts
