THE SPECIFIC MODELS FEATURED ON THE SHOW

Harley-Davidson Dyna

Glide

This is, without a doubt, the most iconic bike of the series. Jax Teller's 2003 Harley-Davidson Dyna Glide is the bike that every fan remembers. Its black-on-black aesthetic, custom two-into-one exhaust, and aggressive stance made it the star of the show. Dyna Glides are highly sought after in the used market, and many current owners build their bikes to mirror this exact look. When browsing **Sons Of Anarchy bikes for sale**, the Dyna platform is often the most popular starting point.

Harley-Davidson Super Glide

Used by several members of the fictional SAMCRO crew, the Super Glide is a workhorse model. It shares the Dyna frame but often comes with a slightly different factory setup. It is a fantastic base for a custom build because it is rugged, reliable, and relatively affordable compared to other Harley models. Many of the background bikes in the clubhouse scenes were Super Glides.

Harley-Davidson Road Glide

and Electra Glide

For the club's longer runs and the more senior members, touring bikes like the Road Glide (famously ridden by Clay Morrow) were used. These bikes offer a different feel—larger, heavier, and equipped with fairings. Finding a used, modified touring bike that matches the SOA aesthetic is possible, though they tend to be priced higher due to their size and complexity.

WHERE TO FIND SONS OF ANARCHY BIKES FOR SALE

Now that you know what you are looking for, the next logical question is: where do you find them? The market for **Sons Of Anarchy bikes for sale** is spread across several channels, each with its own advantages and risks.

Online Marketplaces

Websites like eBay Motors, Cycle Trader, and Craigslist are primary sources. You can search specifically for terms like "SOA build," "SAMCRO replica," or "custom Dyna." KEY CONSIDERATIONS WHEN BUYING A CUSTOM SOA BIKE

Buying a custom motorcycle is not the same as buying a stock model. There are specific risks and nuances you must understand before you hand over your money. Here are the most critical factors to evaluate when looking at **Sons Of Anarchy bikes for sale**.

Authenticity vs. Interpretation

Are you looking for a perfect replica of Jax Teller's bike, or do you want a bike that is inspired by the show but built with your own taste in mind? Perfect replicas are difficult to find and expensive. Many bikes marketed as SOA replicas are actually just heavily customized Harleys that have been given a black paint job and

ape hangers. Decide early on how strict you want to be with the accuracy of the build.

Build Quality and Safety

A custom bike is only as good as the person who built it. Poor wiring, improperly fitted brake lines, and substandard fabrication can make a bike dangerous. When you find **Sons Of Anarchy bikes for sale**, insist on seeing the bike in person. Check the welds, look at the wiring harness, and feel the brakes. If the bike was built by a reputable shop, ask for documentation. If it was a home build, be extra cautious.

Legal Compliance and Title Issues

Maintenance History

Harley-Davidson motorcycles are durable, but they require regular maintenance. Ask for receipts and service records. A bike that looks good but has not been serviced properly could become a money pit. Pay special attention to the condition of the engine seals, the transmission, and the tires. A set of high-quality custom tires for a Dyna can cost several hundred dollars, so factor that into your budget.

THE COST OF OWNING A PIECE OF TELEVISION HISTORY

Pricing for **Sons Of Anarchy bikes for sale** varies wildly. A stock, older Dyna Glide that you intend to customize yourself can be found for as little as \$5,000 to \$8,000. However, a fully built, high-quality replica from a renowned custom shop can easily command \$20,000 to \$35,000 or more. Screen-used bikes from the show have sold at auction for over \$100,000.

When budgeting, remember to account for insurance, registration, and maintenance. Custom bikes often require specialized mechanics who charge a premium. Owning a bike like this is a commitment, but for the right person, it is an incredibly rewarding experience.

Insurance for Custom Builds

Standard motorcycle insurance policies often do not fully cover the value of custom parts and aftermarket modifications. You need to look for an insurer that offers "agreed value" coverage. This ensures that if your bike is totaled or stolen, you are reimbursed for its custom value, not just the base model value of the motorcycle. Many owners of **Sons Of Anarchy bikes for sale** underestimate this cost, so get a quote before you buy.

BUILDING YOUR OWN VS. BUYING READY-MADE

Buying Ready-Made

Building a bike yourself gives you total control. You can source the exact parts you want and ensure every bolt is torqued to your liking. It is a labor of love that can take months or even years. However, you end up with a bike that is uniquely yours. Many enthusiasts argue that the journey of building the bike is just as important as riding it. If you are handy with tools and have the patience, this can be significantly cheaper than buying a finished custom build.
